The MD STEVTA briefed that NEDUET launched a degree program in one of the engineering disciplines for which Technical Training Center, Mithi is selected temporarily till their new campus is constructed, to establish an engineering department for Thar Institute of Engineering, Science and Technology (TIEST), a NED University Constitute College.

Apart from the four-year degree program, NEDUET will offer short and medium-duration technical programs/ courses in these premises, where technical manpower will be provided for local industry.

The Board accorded the post fecto approval in public interest to launch a degree program by NEDUET in the premises of VTC Mithi for temporary basis until the construction of their new campus has been completed.

2.4 Cancelation of Lease Agreement of Bahria Foundation College, Sanghar

The MD STEVTA briefed that Since its establishment, of the building of GPI (W), Sanghar was handed to the Bahria Foundation, with the approval of District Government, Sanghar in 2003 through a lease agreement for the period of (15) fifteen years.

The Sindh TEVTA was established in 2009 with the mission and vision of promoting Technical & Vocational Training programs in the province of Sindh, since 2003, the Bahria Foundation is taking General Education classes at GPI (W), Sanghar, and Sindh TEVTA is not getting its desired results which Sindh TEVTA is meant for.

The institutes of same nature which are running except technical education shall be reviewed and placed in forthcoming meeting.

After detailed deliberation it has been decided that the building of GPI (W), Sanghar has to be evacuated from Bahria Foundation for enabling Sindh TEVTA to start its Technical courses as per the Aims and Objectives.

3.1 Modification in STEVTA HQ Organogram (Addition of New Posts of BS-06 to BS-16)

The MD STEVTA apprised to the board that since the establishment of authority the board in consideration of emerging need and workload for efficient functionalization reviewed and curtail the posts at Sindh TEVTA HQ, Khi from time to time.

	3.3	Implementation of Court Orders vide CP NO. 2516/2010	The MD STEVTA apprised that Mr. Rahib Ali, an incumbent was appointed on a contract basis as Chowkidar (BPS-01) on fixed pay RS. 2,150/- per month by the Executive District Officer (Education) Sukkur vide an order dated 20.08.2007, but due to unknown reason, the	disburse the salary of petitioner for un expired period from the date of

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said appointment was canceled / withdrawn, ab initio by the then EDO (Education), Sukkur vide another order dated 08.11.2007.

Consequent upon the termination of contract incumbent approached the court of law and court ordered as follows:

"Since the Order passed by the EDO terminating services of the petitioner is arbitrary and states no reasons, the same is consequently set aside and the petitioner is ordered to be reinstated in service, for the un-expired period of the contract. It goes without saying that it is always available to the competent authority to deal with all mattes and cases before it in accordance with law. Petition stands disposed of."

Later on petitioner filled a contempt application vide CMA No. 8232/12 wherein court orders on 06.04.2021 to comply with the previous orders in its letter and spirit within one month to avoid the contempt proceedings.

The incumbent may be considered on duty with effect from the date of his termination of service and the salary in lieu thereof for the un-expired period (2 Years, 9 Months, and 11 Days ) shall be payable to the petitioner @ Rs. 2,150/- per month. The financial implication of said decision shall be as follows:

Rs. 2,150/- x 34.4 months =Rs. 73,960/- (Rupees Seventy Three Thousand and Nine Hundred & Sixty Only Lump sum)

2150/- per month considering him on duty for such period.

Whereas, the petitioner may be considered for regularization of service under STEVTA rules. The Board upon request of Director, Managing agreed to regularize the services of Mr. Rahib Ali.
