The Managing Director apprised that the Finance Department, Govt:of Sindh allocates budget grant to STEVTA through Lapsable Assignment Account and the funds are released on quarterly basis. In order to get release the allocated funds, the Finance Department is approached almost thrice through the Administrative Department for releasing of funds i-e. once for the approval for release of funds, then for the authentication of audit copies and then for the permission to place the funds. Thereafter the AG Sindh is approached to place the funds at Assignment Account being maintained at National Bank of Pakistan. The record reveals that sometimes the funds are released at the end of May or at beginning of June due to mentioned above time taken process. Resultantly a major portion of such release is lapsed every year; being lapsable assignment account resulting STEVTA is not achieved functional targets.
