



## QUAID-E-AZAM MUHAMMAD ALI JINNAH MESSAGE ON REORIENTATION OF EDUCATION

*(An Extract from message to All Pakistan Educational Conference, Karachi, November 27, 1947)*



“.. if we are to make any real, speedy and substantial progress, we must earnestly tackle this question and bring our educational policy and programme on the lines suited to the genius of our people, consonant with our history and culture, and having regard to the modern conditions and vast developments that have taken place all over the world.

There is no doubt that the future of our State will and must greatly depend upon the type of education and the way in which we bring up our children as the future servants of Pakistan.

Education does not merely mean academic education, and even that appears to be of a very poor type. What we have to do is to mobilize our people and build up the character of our future generations.

There is immediate and urgent need for training our people in the scientific and technical education in order to build up future economic life, and we should see that our people undertake scientific commerce, trade and particularly, well-planned industries.

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## 1. INTRODUCTION

### 1.1 BRIEF HISTORY

Globalization generates new demands, structures, and systems requiring new skills and knowledge. In today's global economy driven by knowledge, the foremost wealth of a firm is its human capital. Therefore, the Economic Development of a country strongly depends on the level of Human Development that in turn depends on the level of technically trained labour. Skilled labour results in improved productivity for Industry. A country with wide ranging Industrial base generates greater employment opportunities and reduces un-employment and poverty. For optimum performance by Industry, productive workforce is needed to meet economic and social objectives.

Pakistan with a labour surplus economy, on one side has rapidly increasing unemployed youth while on the other end its public and private sector employers desperately look for technically educated and trained workforce. The shortage of skilled labour is due to a mismatch between academic Programmes and market-oriented skills and trainings.

Keeping in view the changing domestic and international labour market requirements and in line with the scheme of reorganization of Technical & Vocational Education and Training (TVET) Institutions adopted by other provinces, Sindh Technical Education and Vocational Training Authority (STEVTA) was established through the STEVTA Ordinance, 2007 (Ordinance XVII of 2007) to streamline the Technical Education and Vocational Training in the province.

After the approval of the Sindh Cabinet in its meeting held on February 28, 2009, the administrative control of all TVET Institutions have been entrusted to STEVTA and subsequently in 2009, the Sindh Assembly passed the STEVTA Bill, 2009 on March 29, 2010, and enacted as The Sindh Technical Education & Vocational Training Authority Act, 2009 on April 20, 2010.

In order to extend complete autonomy for reorganization and effective management, the policy making task has been entrusted to the STEVTA Board of Governors (BoG). The BoG comprises of 20 members, with representation from the Provincial Government (20%), Provincial Departments (50%), and Private Sector (30%).

### 1.2 PURPOSE

To streamline, strengthen and regulate Technical & Vocational Education and Training (TVET), in line with domestic and international job market requirements, for greater employability of youth of Sindh.

3. STUDENT AFFAIRS

3.1 RULES AND REGULATIONS

Trainees are required to always abide by the rules and regulations in force. The institute shall notify a Student Affairs Committee (SAC) with the aim to provide support to trainee’s welfare, counselling & vocational guidance, Extra & co-curricular activities and overall development.

### 3.2 DISCIPLINE

- a. Trainees are bound to maintain proper discipline in the institutions as well its surroundings. Any breach of discipline shall render the trainee liable to expulsion after due course of procedure.
- b. The institute shall notify a Disciplinary Committee (DC) with the aim to address any disciplinary issue and recommend suitable measures to ensure overall discipline, such as but not limited to expulsion, imposition of specific fines, interpretation of rules and all such matters relevant thereto.
- c. The Disciplinary Committee shall be the final authority in the matters pertaining to disciplinary and the decision shall be final binding on all concerned.
- d. The Head of Institute, on the recommendation of Disciplinary Committee, shall have absolute power to expel any trainee from the institute or reject his / her Examination Form on disciplinary / misconduct grounds.

### 3.3 ATTENDANCE

- a. The trainee shall be liable to maintain regular attendance.
- b. Admission of the trainee having less than 75% attendance shall be liable for termination / not allowed to sit in examination as per the notified Attendance Promotion Rules of the concerned Qualification Awarding Body (QAB) / Examination Board.
- c. The Head of Institute is responsible to alert / intimate the parent of the trainees who have less than 75% attendance at least One month prior to closing of the classes.

### 3.4 BOOKS AND INSTRUMENTS

- a. Trainee are required to purchase necessary books, stationery, and instruments at his / her own expenses.
- b. The list of books and required instruments may be obtained from the concerned subject faculty.

### 3.5 TRAINEE IDENTIFICATION CARD

- a. All trainees shall wear their Identification Card at all times while in the institute and its surroundings.
- b. Trainees without their Identification Card shall not be allowed access into the Classrooms, Laboratories, Library, Canteen area or any other Institute facilities.
- c. Trainees shall present their Identification Card upon request by any STEVTA officials, administrative staff, and faculty members.
- d. If a violation of the Code of Conduct is suspected, any STEVTA officials, administrative staff, and faculty members shall have the authority to confiscate the Trainee's Identification Card and submit it to the Head of Institute till the matter is duly resolved by the Disciplinary Committee.

### 3.6 INSTITUTE UNIFORM & PROTECTIVE CLOTHING IN LABORATORIES / WORKSHOPS

- Trainees are required to wear the prescribed Institute uniform and strictly observe the approved dressing code, including wearing the Identification Card at all times in the institute and its surroundings.
- While working in workshops and laboratories, all trainees shall be required to wear Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) such as Eye goggles, Safety Helmet, Protective gloves, Safety shoes, Ear muffs, Protective clothing etc.
- Trainees are required to purchase the required PPE at their own expenses.

### 3.7 LEAVE

- Prior permission / sanction for Leave shall be mandatory to be obtained from the Head of Institute, as the case may be, except in cases of an emergency, such as sickness, death in immediate family etc.
- In case of medical emergency, the trainee has to submit the medical certificate from a registered medical practitioner along with the Leave application, prior to resuming classes.
- Leave, even if granted shall not be exempted from any test, examination or other specific assigned task, laboratory or workshop assignment or fulfilment of mandatory attendance as per requirement of the concerned Qualification Awarding Body (QAB) / Examination Board.

### 3.8 SUBSTANCE ABUSE

Possession, use, purchase, and/or distribution of alcohol or intoxicating drugs (such as but not limited to heroin, opiates, cocaine, marijuana, hashish, alcoholic beverages, or other intoxicating substances) is **strictly prohibited inside the institute and its surroundings, transport vehicle, events and activities.**

### 3.9 TOBACCO USAGE

As per the **Prohibition of Smoking and Protection of Non-Smokers Health Ordinance 2002** and the Ministry of Health, Government of Pakistan Notification No. **S.R.O. 51 (KE)**, Dated: June 15, 2009, all types of tobacco product (e.g. Cigarette, Beedi, Sheesha / Hookah, Electronic cigarette, Vape pen or any other Electronic Nicotine Delivery System (ENDS) etc.) and the use of oral tobacco product (e.g. Mainpuri, Gutka etc.) is **strictly prohibited inside the institute and its surroundings, transport vehicle, events and activities.**

### 3.10 FALSE REPRESENTATION

- False representation is a violation of the Code of Conduct, such as lending your Identification Card to others for any purposes, forging signatures, and providing false information to mislead authorities.
- Forgery, alteration, unauthorized possession, or use of official documents, records, or instruments of identification, as well as forged or fraudulent communications (paper or electronic) shall lead to disciplinary actions, including expulsion and fines.

### 3.11 UNAUTHORIZED ENTRY OR ACCESS

Unauthorized entry into or presence within Institute, including access into Offices, Classrooms, Laboratories, Library, Canteen area or any other Institute facilities is prohibited.

### 3.12 HARASSMENT, RAGGING AND BULLYING

- a. Harassment, defined as inappropriate, severe, persistent, and pervasive conduct that affects morale and functioning including verbal, electronic, written, or physical communication is a serious violation of the Code of Conduct.
- b. Trainees and staff shall report any incident to the Head of Institute immediately.
- c. Harassment, Ragging and bullying include:
  - Psychological, Racial, Ethnical, Religious, Sexual involving non-consensual words, actions, or behaviours.
  - Menacing behaviour or threats to coerce compliance.
  - Teasing or rude handling of others.
  - Rowdy or undisciplined activities causing annoyance, hardship, or harm.
  - Disruption of academic activities.
  - Exploitation for academic tasks.
  - Financial extortion or forceful expenditure.

### 3.13 FALSE ALLEGATIONS

- a. Deliberately making false accusations is a violation of the Code of Conduct.
- b. Anyone found to be making any false allegation shall be liable for disciplinary actions, including expulsion and fines.

### 3.14 THEFT AND VANDALISM

- a. Theft, negligence, or intentional damage to personal or institutional property is prohibited.
- b. Any person found to be in violation shall be charged for repair and replacement and be liable for the stringent disciplinary actions, including expulsion, maximum fines and shall be reported to the law enforcement agencies.

### 3.15 WEAPONS AND EXPLOSIVES

- a. STEVTA has a zero-tolerance policy regarding possession or use of firearms, dangerous devices, chemicals, or **inside the institute and its surroundings, transport vehicle, events and activities.**
- b. Any person found to be in violation shall be liable for the stringent disciplinary actions, including expulsion, maximum fines and shall be reported to the law enforcement agencies.

### 3.16 FIRE SAFETY

- a. Actions that can may fire within the institution and its surrounds are strictly prohibited.

- b. The Head of Institute shall ensure regular fire drills, post fire drill procedures on the notice boards and key locations all over the institute, and maintain upkeep of the firefighting and safety equipment.
- c. Trainees are financially responsible for any damages from reckless conduct or policy violations.

### 3.18 LOST AND FOUND ITEMS

- a. All lost and found items shall be handed over to the Head of the Institute immediately and shall be logged for safekeeping and return.
- b. All the lost and found items shall be recorded in the lost and found register, and shall be given a unique identification number, description, location where it was found, and the name of the person who found it.
- c. After the lost and found item is catalogued, it shall be stored securely in a locker which is only accessible by the Head of Institute.
- d. The person who found the item shall sign the register upon delivering the item to the Head of Institute.
- e. Upon verification of ownership, both the owner and the Head of Institute shall sign the register at the time of returning the item to its owner.
- f. No one is permitted to take any lost and found items out of the institute premises, for any reason.

### 3.19 ASSESSMENT AND PROMOTION RULES

The trainees shall be assessed and promoted as per the notified Assessment and Promotion Rules of the concerned Qualification Awarding Body (QAB) / Examination Board.

### 3.20 REFUND OF SECURITY DEPOSIT

- a. Application for refund of security deposit along-with clearance certificate maybe submitted within three years from the date the trainee discontinued or pass out his / her training programme.
- b. The claim shall be forfeited, if the trainees does not claim the refund within the prescribed time.

## 4. SCHOLARSHIP

### 4.1 FULL / HALF FREE-SHIP

- a. Fee concession of Full and Half Free-ship **for Morning and Double Shift programme Tuition fee, only**, may be available up to 10% of total enrolment per class.
- b. These Free-ships are awarded on annual basis to the deserving trainees, as per policy approved by the Government of Sindh from time to time.

### 4.2 MERIT SCHOLARSHIP

Merit Scholarship may be awarded on annual basis to the meritorious trainees, as per policy approved by the Government of Sindh from time to time.

5. GENDER MAINSTREAMING POLICY

To promote, support and encourage gender equality and equity, female Candidates are allowed admissions in the previously Males-only institutes, as per merit / policy.

**NB:**

- a. All applicants for admission on reserved seats should apply through their respective Agency / Department / Provincial Technical Education & Vocational Training Authorities (TEVTAs).
- b. In each class, not more than one Candidate shall be allowed admission from each category.
- c. The admission to nominated Candidates shall be allowed purely on merit within category / group.

6.2 PROCEDURE FOR ADMISSION AGAINST RESERVED SEATS

Candidates seeking admission on Reserved Seat, may apply through the concerned Department within due date. Only nominations received through proper channel and within due date shall be entertained.

6.2.1 Reserved Seat for Children of Defence Personnel

- a. Candidates who are children of Army Personnel may apply through The General Headquarters, Rawalpindi only.

- b. Candidates who are children of Navy Personnel may apply through The Naval Headquarters, Islamabad only.
- c. Candidates who are children of Air Force Personnel may apply through The Air Headquarters, Peshawar only.

#### 6.2.2 Reserved Seat on Reciprocal Basis

Candidates seeking admission on Reciprocal seats may apply through the respective Technical Vocational Education Authorities (TEVTAs), e.g. Candidates of Punjab domicile may apply through Punjab TEVTA Headquarters, Lahore.

#### 6.2.3 Reserved Seat for Special Zones

- a. Candidates applying on Reserved seats for Makran Division, Baluchistan may apply through concerned nominating Authority for Makran Division, Baluchistan.
- b. Candidates applying on Reserved seats for ex-FATA Region may apply through The Home & Tribal Affairs (HTA) Department, Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Peshawar.
- c. Candidates applying on Reserved seats for Azad Jammu & Kashmir may apply through The Nomination Board, Azad Jammu & Kashmir.
- d. Candidates applying on Reserved seats for Northern Areas may apply through the Kashmir Affairs and Northern Affairs (KANA) Division, Government of Pakistan.

#### 6.2.4 Reserved seats for Person with Disability

Candidates applying on Reserved seats for Person with Disability may submit an attested copy of their Special Computerized National Identity Card (SCNIC), issued by the National Database & Registration Authority (NADRA), along with the Admission Form in the desired institute within due date.

#### 6.2.5 Reserved seats for Transgender Person

Candidates applying on Reserved seats for Transgender Person may submit an attested copy of their Computerized National Identity Card (CNIC), issued by the National Database & Registration Authority (NADRA), along with the Admission Form in the desired institute within due date.

#### 6.2.6 Reserved seats for Real Sons / Daughters / Sisters / Brothers of the Employees and Employees of STEVTA, SBTE and STTB

Candidates seeking admission on Reserved seats for Real Sons / Daughters / Sisters / Brothers of the Employees and Employees of STEVTA, Sindh Board of Technical Education (SBTE) and Sindh Trade Testing Board (STTB) shall submit the applications to Regional Directorate through the Head of Institutions / Offices within due date.

## 7. SCOPE OF DIPLOMA OF ASSOCIATE ENGINEERING (DAE) PROGRAMME

Industry largely depends on technicians for production, efficient operation & maintenance, and back-up support. An Associate Engineer can extend scientific knowledge & skills for qualitative productivity. The Sindh Board of Technical Education (SBTE) in 25 Technologies awards the Diploma of Associate Engineering (DAE) certificates. The Government of Pakistan recognizes 3-Year DAE equivalent to Intermediate for further vertical mobility towards higher studies.

### 7.1 JOB OPPORTUNITIES

The DAE pass-outs can either proceed for further studies or get employment as Supervisors, Foremen, Sales Engineers, Shift Engineers, Sub-Engineers, Surveyors, Service Station Managers, Auto Engineers, Agricultural Overseers, Farm Managers, Instructors, Workshop Superintendents, IT related Jobs such as Data Consultant, Operators, Website developer, Hardware & Software Technicians, Architect, Office Management (Middle Management) in Public & Private Sector etc.

Moreover, pass-outs may have many opportunities of self-employment (Entrepreneurship) as well.

### 7.2 HIGHER EDUCATION OPPORTUNITIES

DAE is equivalent to Intermediate (Pre-Engineering). Diploma holders are eligible for following opportunities of further education:

- Bachelor in Science Engineering Technology (BS Engineering Technology)
- Bachelor of Engineering (B.E. / BS Engineering) offered by the Engineering Universities as per their policy.
- Bachelor in Science / Computer / Commerce / Administration / Humanities & Arts

## 8. ADMISSION POLICY OF DIPLOMA OF ASSOCIATE ENGINEERING (DAE)

### 8.1 ADMISSION PROCEDURE

The admission shall be institute-specific. All Candidates shall specify their preference for **Institute** and **Technology** on the Admission Form.

### 8.2 ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

#### 8.2.1 ENTRY QUALIFICATION

- Secondary School Certificate (SSC) / Matric (all) or Equivalent with minimum 40% Marks.
- Technical School Certificate (TSC) / Matric (Technical) with minimum 40% Marks.

#### 8.2.2 INELIGIBILITY

- Less than 40% marks in Secondary School Certificate (SSC) / Technical School Certificate (TSC) / Matric (all) or Equivalent
- Failing any Subject in Secondary School Certificate (SSC) / Technical School Certificate (TSC) / Matric (all) or Equivalent
- Not within Age brackets as specified below.
- Any form without attachment of deposit voucher / slip.
- In case of any entry in the Admission Form found to be incorrect, incomplete, or illegible.

#### 8.2.3 DISQUALIFICATION

- Any attempt directly or indirectly to influence / intimidate Admission authorities.
- Any alteration or manipulation in the Admission Form / Documents.
- Parallel admission in any other educational institution or Board in the same shift.

10. ADMISSION PROCESS

10.1 PURCHASE & SUBMISSION OF ADMISSION FORMS

- a. Prospective Candidates may obtain the Admission Package (i.e. Prospectus and Academic Form) in Hard Copy against prescribed Fee (PKR 250/-) from any STEVTA institute, all over the province.
- b. The prospective Candidate shall submit the duly-filled Admission Form, along with all requisite documents, in the desired STEVTA Institutes for admission within due date.
- c. No form shall be accepted after the due date mentioned below.

10.2 MERIT ORDER

- a. Admission is granted as per allocation according to merit determined by the Institute Admission Committee on the basis of Percentage of Marks obtained in Secondary School Certificate (SSC) / Matric (all) or Equivalent.

- b. 23. SCOPE OF NATIONAL VOCATIONAL CERTIFICATE (NVC) PROGRAMME

Industry largely depends on technicians for production, efficient maintenance, and back-up support. A technician play pivotal role in productivity of industry. In Vocational Training programme, hands-on skill training is provided to trainees to become employed. The Sindh Board of Technical Education (SBTE) & the Sindh Testing Board (STTB) awards the National Vocational Certificate (NVC) Level-2 to Level-5

23.1 JOB OPPORTUNITIES

After successful completion of the NVC programme, trainees may get employment as a *Technician, Sales Representative, Draughtsman, Service Technician, Auto Technician, Agricultural Technician, Junior Instructors* etc.

23.2 HIGHER EDUCATION OPPORTUNITIES

- The Trainee who successfully complete National Vocational Certificate (NVC) Level-2 will be eligible to acquire the next level of NVC qualification up to level-5, which is equivalent to Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC) / Intermediate, as per the National Vocational Qualification Framework (NVQF).
- Subsequently, they may also avail admission in the 4-year BS Engineering Technology programmes.

24. ADMISSION POLICY OF NATIONAL VOCATIONAL CERTIFICATE (NVC) PROGRAMMES

24.1 ADMISSION PROCEDURE

The admissions shall be institute-based. All applicants will specify their preference for Trade in the order of priority.

24.2 ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

24.2.1 ENTRY QUALIFICATION

- Secondary School Certificate (SSC) / Matric (all) or Equivalent with minimum 40% Marks.
- Technical School Certificate (TSC) / Matric (Technical) with minimum 40% Marks.
- Middle (8<sup>th</sup> Class) or Equivalent (in selected Trades) with minimum 40% Marks.
- Literate or Primary pass (In selected Trades only)

24.2.2 INELIGIBILITY

- Less than 40% marks in SSC / TSC/ Middle
- Failing in any Subject of SSC / TSC/ Middle
- Not within Age brackets as specified below.
- Any form without attachment of deposit voucher / slip.
- In case of any entry in the Admission Form found to be incorrect, incomplete, or illegible.

24.2.3 DISQUALIFICATION

- Any attempt directly or indirectly to influence / intimidate Admission authorities.
- Any alteration or manipulation in the Admission Form / Documents.
- Parallel admission in any other educational institution or Board in the same shift.


